- 2) **ESSAY**: On a separate typed sheet, in <u>500 words or less</u>, describe the positive contribution(s) you have made to MHS.
 - We are looking for engaged members of the MHS community who may or may not be elected leaders.
 - Please do not include examples of external work that did not directly benefit MHS.
 - This scholarship recognizes students who will leave <u>MHS</u> a better place because of their positive contributions to the school's social, emotional, physical, cultural, or academic environment.
 - <u>NOTE</u>: In your essay, use Arial 14-point font and double space. Indicate your word count in the bottom right corner of the typed essay.
- 3) <u>INTERVIEW</u>: Each scholarship candidate will be required to participate in a 15-minute interview with our committee. Interview dates are Tuesday, April 26 and Wednesday April 27 from 2:00 pm 7:00 pm. You will be contacted in April by Guidance via Naviance email to select a convenient interview time.

Notes:

- Scholarships are awarded based on your positive contributions to MHS; not academics or financial need.
- All essays will be reviewed by 3-4 volunteers. To ensure fairness, applicants' names will be removed from the essays before they are evaluated.
- If selected, you must be present at the scholarship awards ceremony on June 8th to receive your award.
